RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is respectfully recommended that the City Council consider a request by Farmersville High School Football for complimentary use of City Community Center on May 7th, 2016.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Mayor Gomez received a requested for sponsorship in the form of complimentary use of the City's Community Center, the afternoon and evening of May 7, 2016 to hold a funding raising dinner for the Farmersville High School football program.

This is an opportunity for the City, at no cost, to support a community organization that improves the quality of life in Farmersville by teaching discipline, good sportsmanship, promoting athletics and positive healthy activities to Farmersville High School football players.
