

RESOLUTION 2023-024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive an estimated \$256,695 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2023-24 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fifth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has incorporated public input into our community's transportation priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate various City streets/roads and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year and similar projects in the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an at-risk condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a good condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive benefits including reducing drive times and traffic congestion, improving bicycle safety, and making the pedestrian experience safer and more appealing, which leads to reducing vehicle emissions helping the State achieve its air quality and greenhouse gas emissions reductions goals.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Farmersville, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following scope of work for proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues is as followed:

A. Pavement Management Program: Ongoing Street Repairs, which includes road repair and reconstruction/rehabilitation, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and other ADA infrastructure improvements. This project is in the City of Farmersville and includes the following roadway segments:

N. Virginia from W. Costner Street to W. Front Street
N. June Avenue from W. Costner Street to W. Ash Street
N. Steven Avenue from W. Visalia Road to W. Ash Street

N. Rose Avenue from E. Costner Street to E. Ash Street
N. Sandy Avenue from E. Yew Street to E. Front Street
N. Hester Avenue from E. Visalia Road to E. Costner Street
N. Gene Avenue from E. Visalia Road to cul de sac
N. Dwight Avenue from E. Visalia Road to E. Elm Street
N. Oakview Avenue from E. Elm Street to E. Pepper Street

W. Costner Street from N. Virginia Avenue to N. Steven Avenue
W. Ash Street from N. Virginia Avenue to N. Steven Avenue
W. Front Street from N. Virginia Avenue to Farmersville Boulevard

E. Larry Street from E. Visalia Road to N. Gene Avenue
E. Birch Street from N. Magnolia Avenue to E. Costner Street
E. Costner Street from Farmersville Boulevard to N. Hester Avenue
E. Elm Street from N. Dwight Avenue to N. Oakview Avenue
E. Yew Street from N. Sandy Avenue to N. Gene Avenue
E. Pepper Street from N. Oakview Avenue to N. Brundage Avenue
E. Front Street from Farmersville Boulevard to N. Dwight Avenue

The project construction completion is scheduled in the 2024/2025 fiscal year. The anticipated life of this project is 10-15 years.


