

RESOLUTION 2021-045

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE
ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR SPECIAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF
FARMERSVILLE**

WHEREAS, the City of Farmersville had previously set fees associated with a cost recovery program for the special services provided by the City for residents, businesses, and other interested partners nearly ten years prior; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the cost of services reasonably borne by individuals should be up-to-date and accurate when at all possible; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmersville has accepted and filed the study entitled "Cost of Services Study for the City of Farmersville" dated July 2, 2021, which was presented by Revenue & Cost Specialists, LLC (RCS) at a previous public meeting on August 23rd, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the study was performed by RCS with City staff to determine the actual total costs of providing special services by the City of Farmersville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a study session to further examine findings of the study and provide direction as to the creation of an updated service fee schedule for special services provided by City staff at a previous public meeting on August 30th, 2021; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Farmersville as follows to be effective on January 1, 2022:

1. In order to implement a cost recovery program and to incorporate all other such fees previously adopted by the City Council, "Exhibit A" of this resolution is attached hereto and made a part of the resolution setting forth the schedule of fees to be collected for the services enumerated herein; and
2. That the accurate billing and collection of amounts invoiced under "Exhibit A" are critical to the City's cost recovery program and unpaid invoices unreasonably increase the taxpayer's burden, the Director of Finance and Administration is authorized to take appropriate steps to ensure collection of amounts owed included, but not limited to, combining all accounts due for services into a single invoice or account, adding past due amounts to utility or business license accounts to be collected when the account is due or renewed, as well a filing court actions and sending past due accounts to collection agencies, as appropriate and permitted by law.


