



Notice of Removal of Existing Crosswalk Ash Street at Hester Avenue

Project Description: Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21950.5, notice is hereby given that the previously marked crosswalk that was across the east leg of the intersection of Ash Street at Hester Avenue will not be reinstalled. A crosswalk safety study was recently completed for this location and due to conflicting utilities prohibiting the installation of an accessible curb ramp on the north side of the east leg of the intersection, as well as a higher pedestrian demand for the crossing on the west leg of the intersection, it was recommended that the school crossing be relocated to the west leg of the intersection.

The crosswalk safety study was presented to and approved by the City Council on January 8, 2024. A copy of the study is included in the agenda packet for the January 8, 2024 City Council meeting located on the City's website.

Public Comment: Public comments regarding the removal of the crosswalk and the proposed plan to relocate the crosswalk to the west leg of the intersection are welcome and must be submitted in writing by May 6, 2024. Please submit comments by mail to:
